### Configuration du système

### 2. Installation du matériel

<u>Remarque :</u> Après avoir terminé l'installation du matériel, utilisez l'utilitaire Smart basé Internet pour configurer le TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS. Pour y accéder, ouvrez votre navigateur Internet et saisissez l'adresse IP par défaut <u>http://192.168.0.1</u> et le mot de passe par défaut « admin ». Assurez-vous que votre ordinateur et le TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS sont configurés sur le même segment de réseau.





### 3. Utilitaire de gestion Internet

<u>Remarque :</u> Si vous désirez découvrir aisément tous les Switches de gestion Internet du réseau, assignez une adresse IP, modifiez le mot de passe et effectuez la mise à jour du firmware. Ensuite installez l'utilitaire de gestion Internet. Suivez les étapes ci-dessous.

#### **Utilisateurs Windows**

1. Insérez le CD-ROM contenant l'utilitaire et le guide de l'utilisateur dans le lecteur de CD-ROM de votre ordinateur et cliquez ensuite sur Install Utility (Installer l'utilitaire).



 Suivez les instructions de l'assistant d'installation. Cliquez sur OK.



 Cliquez sur Start > Programs > web\_management\_utility, et cliquez ensuite sur web\_management\_utility.

4. Cliquez sur **Discovery** (Découvrez), et ensuite doublecliquez sur le **Switch** qui apparaît dans la liste des découvertes (**Discovery List**).





6. Configurez l'adresse IP, le masque de sous réseau, la passerelle, et le mot de passe. Cliquez sur Set (Enregistrer).

Q1: After connecting the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS to a power outlet, the LEDs do not turn on. A1: Check the connection of the power cord to the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS and the power outlet. Also check that the power outlet is receiving power.

# Q2: After installing the Web-Management Utility, I clicked Discovery and the Utility is unable to discover the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS. What should I do?

A2: Make sure that the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS is powered on and that all connections are secure. Also check that your computer's IP Address is on the same network segment as the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS. The default IP Address of the Switch is **192.168.0.1** and the default password is **admin**.

# Q3: When I access the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS using a web browser, I get a screen that tells me "only one user can login". What should I do?

A3: Another computer is configuring the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS. Please wait until the user logs off. If the other user has already logged off and you still get the same screen, then disconnect the power cord from the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS, wait for 5 seconds, reconnect the power cord to the TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS, allow 5 seconds for the Switch to power on, and then attempt to access the web configuration page to login.

Q4: I forgot the administration password. How do I reset my TEG-160WS/TEG-240WS?
A4: Press on the reset button using a pen or paperclip for 10 seconds. The default password is admin.

Q5: When I connect a computer to the Switch's gigabit port, the LINK/ACT LED turns on, but the 100Mbps LED remains off.

A5: When the 1000Mbps LED remains off, the computer's connection speed is 10Mbps or 100Mbps (if the 100Mbps LED is on). Make sure that you have a Gigabit Ethernet adapter installed. Also make sure to use a CAT-5e or CAT- 6 Ethernet cable.
