2. How to Install

Important! DO NOT connect the Wireless USB Adapter to your computer until instructed to do so.

1. Insert the Utility & Driver CD-ROM into your computer's CD-ROM Drive and then click Install Utility & Driver. Then click Windows 2000/XP.



2. Click Run.



3. Click Run.



4. When you reach this screen, select Install Client Utilities and Drivers and then click Next.







7. Select WLAN Client Utility (ACU) and Supplicant and then click Next. (Windows XP only)



<u>Note:</u> The TEW-445UB is hot-pluggable, you can connect or disconnect the TEW-445UB while the computer is on.

8. Plug in the provided USB cable into the TEW-445UB and into an available USB plug on your computer.







Your installation is now complete.



3. Wireless Configuration

<u>Note:</u> Wireless configuration requires a 802.11g or 802.11b Access Point (for Infrastructure Mode) or another 802.11g wireless adapter (for Ad-Hoc/Peer-to-Peer networking mode).







Wireless installation is now complete.

Q1: I inserted the Utility & Driver CD-ROM into my computer's CD-ROM Drive and the installation menu does not appear automatically. What should I do?

A1: If the installation menu does not appear automatically, click Start, click Run, and type D:\setup.exe where "D" in "D:\setup.exe" is the letter assigned to your computer's CD-ROM Drive. And then click OK to start the installation.

Q2: When I open up the utility, all the buttons are greyed out.

A2: Verify that the device is installed properly. Right click on My Computer -> Properties. Click on Hardware, then Device Manager. Double click on Network Adapters. Make sure that WLAN USB 2.0 Wireless Network Adapter is listed and there is no yellow question mark or exclamation point. Also perform a reboot on the computer.

Q3: When I click on Scan, I can not see my SSID.

A3: Log on to your wireless router or access point and make sure that the SSID broadcast option is not disabled. Make sure the wireless light on your wireless router or access point is on.

Q4: I completed all the steps in the Quick Installation Guide, but my Wireless USB Adapter isn't connecting to my access point. What should I do?

A4: First, verify that the Network Name (SSID) matches your wireless router or wireless access point's SSID. Second, check your TCP/IP properties to ensure that Obtain an IP address automatically is selected. Third, click **Profile Management -> Scan** in the Wireless Client Utility to check and see if there are any available wireless networks listed.

Q5: The utility program shows good signal strength, but I can not get onto the Internet.

A5: First, log on to your wireless router or access point and check to see if encryption is enable. If encryption is enabled, go to Profile Management -> Modify -> Security. Select the proper Security Options, click on configure, then put in the proper encryption key. Then click Ok. Second, make sure to disable any firewall programs. Third, make sure that your router is properly configured for Internet.
