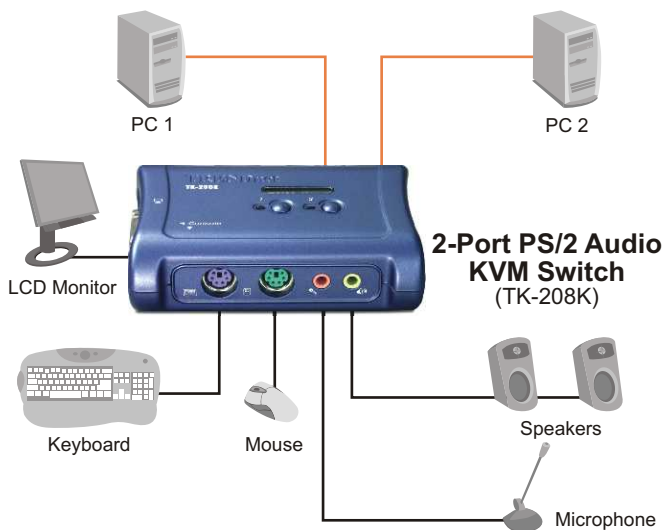
1. Avant de commencer



Configuration du système

2. Comment effectuer les connexions

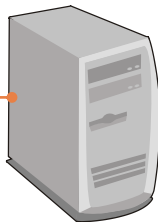
1. Branchez le moniteur au port console du switch.



2. Branchez le clavier, la souris, le micro et les diffuseurs au port console du switch.



3. Utilisez les câbles KVM fournis pour brancher votre PC à votre switch KVM.



4. Branchez l'autre extrémité du câble au port PC du switch.



5. Branchez l'autre extrémité du câble Audio au port Audio du switch.



6. Allumez tous les PC connectés.

L'installation est maintenant complète.

3. Utilisation du switch KVM

Touches d'accès rapide

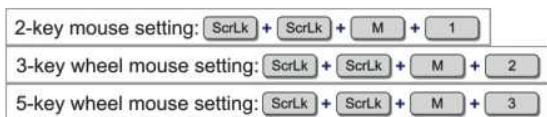
Un raccourci clavier consiste en une combinaison de trois touches :

Accès rapide = ScrLk + ScrLk + Touche(s)

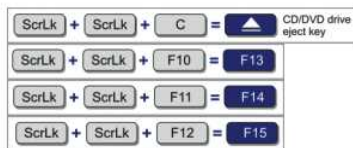
Après avoir appuyé sur la touche ScrLk, vous disposez de 2 secondes pour appuyer à nouveau sur cette dernière. Vous disposez alors de 2 secondes supplémentaires pour appuyer sur une touche de commande. Si vous n'enfoncez aucune touche dans les deux secondes, le mode « accès rapide » est annulé.

Remarque

1. Les commandes de raccourci ne fonctionnent qu'avec les touches numériques de la rangée supérieure
2. Lorsque la liaison des permutations de ports PC et Audio/Micro est activée par un raccourci clavier, toutes les permutations PC et Audio/Micro sont reliées.
3. Pour les systèmes d'exploitation non PnP (Linux, Windows NT 4.0), veuillez utiliser les commandes suivantes pour réinitialiser les paramètres de la souris.



4. Remarque à l'usage des utilisateurs Mac : Pour passer d'un clavier PC standard à un clavier MAC :



Convention concernant les touches de raccourci :

La séquence signifie que vous devez enfoncer chaque touche consécutivement et non simultanément.

Q1: Where is the power supply? I did not find one in the box.

A1: The TK-208K does not require a power supply. It draws power from your computer's PS/2 connections. As long as your KVM switch is connected to the PS/2 port, it will receive the necessary power to function.

Q2: I have the KVM switch connected properly, but my keyboard and mouse don't work.

A2: Please make sure your PS/2 port is working properly by testing it with your other PS/2 devices. Once you confirm that the PS/2 port is functional, please reboot your computers, and try to use the KVM switch again.

Q3: Can I connect and disconnect the PS/2 cables while the computers are turned on?

A3: Yes, you can connect or disconnect the PS/2 cables while the computers are turned on because the PS/2 interface is Plug-and-Play and Hot-Pluggable.

Q4: Will the KVM switch remember the keyboard settings between computers?

A4: Yes, the KVM switch will remember the keyboard settings when switching between your computers. (i.e.: Cap lock, Num key, etc.)

Q5: How do I switch from one computer to another with the KVM switch?

A5: You may switch between PCs by pressing the Push button on the KVM switch or by using the Hot-Key commands.
