
1. Before You Start



System Requirements

- Windows 98SE/ME/2000/XP/Vista
- Available USB 1.1 or 2.0 port

Application



2. Install Hardware

<u>Note</u>: If you are installing a new printer, you may need to install the driver for your printer. Refer to your printer's user manual for driver installation.

 Turn on your computer and wait until the Windows desktop appears.



- **2.** Connect the parallel connector to your printer's parallel port, and turn printer ON.
- Connect the Adapter to an available USB port on your computer.



3. Driver Installation

Note: For Windows 2000/XP/Vista, drivers will install automatically. For Windows ME continue on to step 1. For Windows 98SE, continue on to step 7.

Windows ME

- Go to www.trendnet.com and download the Windows ME/98SE drivers.
- Uncompress the drivers using a compression program (e.g. Winzip).

Select Specify the location of the driver (Advanced) and then click Next.



4. Select **Specify a location** and click **Browse**. Browse towards the driver file and then click **Next**.





5. Click Next.



6. Click Finish.

Windows 98SE

- Go to www.trendnet.com and download the Windows ME/98SE drivers.
- **8.** Uncompress the drivers using a compression program (e.g. Winzip).
- 9. Click Next.



 Select Specify a location and click Browse. Browse towards the driver file and then click Next.

Troubleshooting

Q1: Can I connect or disconnect the USB cables while the computer is on?

A1: Yes, you can connect or disconnect the USB cable while the computer is on, because the USB interface is Plug-and-Play and hot-pluggable.

Q2: My computer has a USB interface but the USB port doesn't seem to work. What should I do?

A2: Check that your computer's BIOS has its USB option enabled. Also verify in the device manager that there are no exclamation points under the Universal Serial Bus Controllers sections. For more information regarding BIOS settings, please refer to your computer's User Manual.
