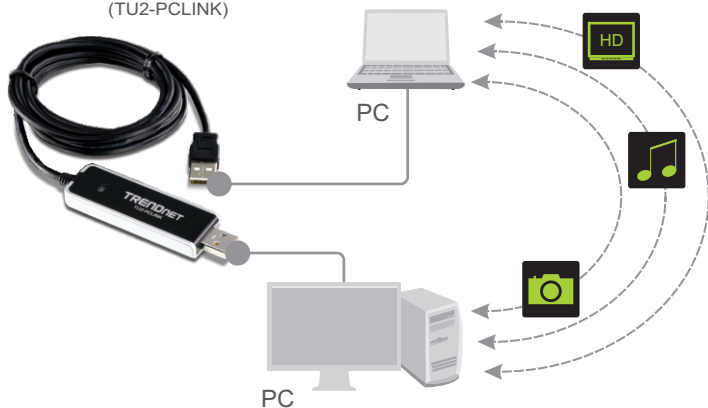

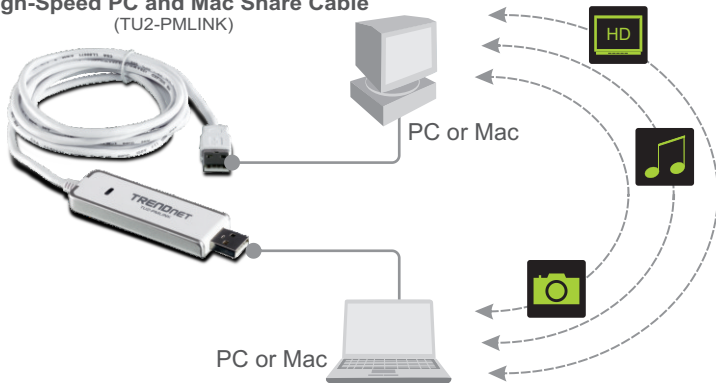

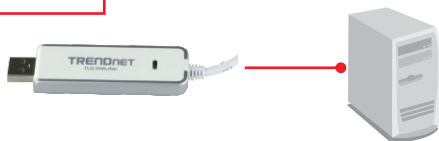
High-Speed PC and Mac Share Cable (TU2-PMLINK)

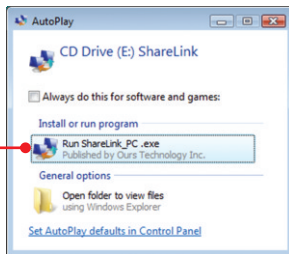

For Window Users

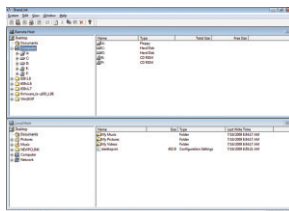
1. Click **Run ShareLink_PC.exe**

1. Double click on the ShareLink icon. This icon will appear on the desktop.



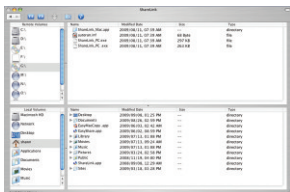

3. Use your mouse to drag and drop files from the Local Volume to the Remote Volume. You can also drag and drop files from the Remote Volume to the Local Volume.

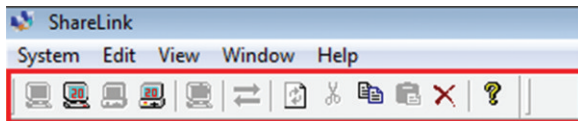

The installation menu does not appear automatically after I connect the TU2-PCLINK/TU2-PMLINK to my computer. What should I do?

For Windows 2000/XP, if the installation menu does not appear automatically, double-click on My Computer. Then double click on ShareLink. For Windows Vista/7, if the installation menu does not appear automatically, double-click on Computer. Then double-click on ShareLink.

My computer does not detect the TU2-PCLINK/TU2-PMLINK. What should I do?

1. Make sure your computer meets the minimum requirements as specified in Section 1 of this quick installation guide.
2. Connect the TU2-PCLINK/TU2-PMLINK into a different USB port on your computer.
