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1. Antes de iniciar

Requisitos mínimos

- Una unidad de CD-ROM
- Cuenta Skype™
- PC con un puerto USB 1.1 ó 2.0 disponible
- CPU: Intel Pentium 400 MHz o superior
- · Memoria: 128MB o más
- · Disco duro: 15MB o más
- Windows XP/2000

<u>Nota:</u> Skype[™] debe instalarse y ejecutarse antes de iniciar el proceso de instalación.

2. Cómo se instala

1. Introduzca el CD-ROM de la herramienta en la unidad de CD-ROM y luego haga clic en Install Utility (Instalar herramienta).



 Siga las instrucciones del InstallShield Wizard (Asistente de InstallShield). Marque Run (Ejecutar) TVP-SP2.exe y después haga clic en Finish (Finalizar).



3. Conecte la punta del USB macho tipo A del cable USB suministrado a un puerto USB disponible en su PC.



 Conecte la punta del USB tipo B del cable USB suministrado al TVP-SP2.



5. Windows lo detectará automáticamente e instalará los controladores apropiados.

6. Seleccione Allow this program to use Skype™ (Permitir que este programa utilice Skype™). Haga clic en OK.

2. Compruebe que el Teléfono USB aparece en la pantalla LCD del TVP-SP2.



Llamar al usuario de Skype™

- Pulse el botón de navegación de Arriba/ Abajo en el teclado numérico del TVP-SP2 para seleccionar el contacto específico.
- Pulse el icono del teléfono verde en el teclado numérico del TVP-SP2 para iniciar la llamada.

Q1: My computer does not detect the TVP-SP2. What should I do?

A1: First, make sure your computer meets the minimum requirements as specified in Section 1 of this Quick Installation Guide. Second, make sure the USB cable is physically plugged in as described in Section 2. Third, try installing the TVP-SP2 to a different USB port of your computer.

Q2: I am unable to make a call. What should I do?

A2: First, make sure that you have Internet connectivity. Second, make sure that you have signed into your Skype [™] account. Third, make sure that you see the **TVP-SP2** software icon located on the system tray ⁽). If you do not see this icon, go to **Start -> Program Files -> TRENDnet -> TVP-SP2**. Fourth, make sure that you have followed the exact steps in section 3 of this Quick Installation Guide.

Q3: The speaker/microphone function does not work. What should I do?

A3: First, make sure that you have installed the TVP-SP2 software program as described in Section 2. Second, right click on the **TVP-SP2** software lcon located on the system tray (s) and select **Audio Device Settings**. Make sure speaker and microphone are set to **USB Audio Device**. Third, right click on the TVP-SP2 software icon and select **Volume Control**. Make sure the volume is set appropriately for the microphone and speaker. Fourth, if you see the microphone icon on the LCD screen, press on the microphone button on the TVP-SP2 keypad.

Q4: How do I switch back to my computer's original audio settings?

A4: Right click on the **TVP-SP2** software icon located on the system tray S and select **Audio Device Settings**. Select the desired **Windows Default Audio Device** for the speaker and microphone. Then click **OK**.
