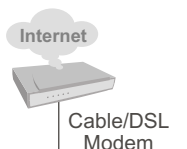

2. How to Install

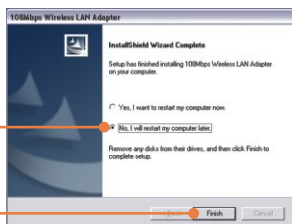
Important! DO NOT install the PCI adapter or PC Card in the computer until instructed to do so.

For Windows Users

1. Insert the **Utility & Driver CD-ROM** into your computer's CD-ROM Drive and then click **Install Utility**.



2. Follow the **InstallShield Wizard** instructions. When prompted to restart computer, select **No** and then click **Finish**.



Note: Please refer to your computer's user manual regarding hardware installation. Then proceed to the appropriate section below.

3. **Shutdown** your computer.



4. Insert PC Card firmly into an available PC Card slot of the notebook PC and then turn **ON** the computer and wait until the Windows desktop appears.



5. Go to **Step 9**.

TEW-443PI

6. **Shutdown** your computer.

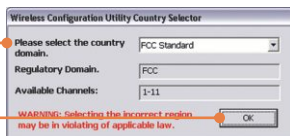


7. Open your computer's case.

8. Insert PCI Card firmly into an available PCI Card slot of the desktop PC, attach the included antenna, and then turn **ON** the computer and wait until the Windows desktop appears.



9. Select the appropriate **country domain** and then click **OK**.

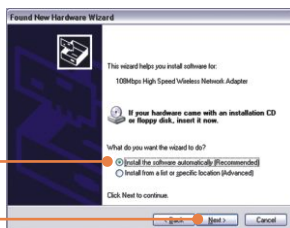


Windows XP

10. The **Found New Hardware Wizard** appears. Select **No**, not this time and then click **Next**.



11. Click **Install the software automatically** and then click **Next**.



12. Click **Finish**.



Windows 2000

Windows 2000 will automatically detect and install the appropriate drivers.

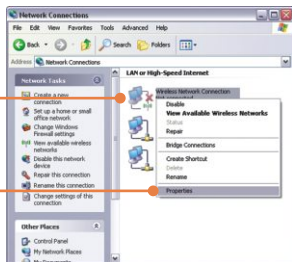

3. Using the Wireless Adapter

Note: Windows XP Wireless Zero Configuration utility must first be disabled. If it is already disabled, then go to Step 4.

1. Go into the **Control Panel** and double-click **Network Connections** icon. Right-click **Wireless Network Connection** icon and click **Properties**.



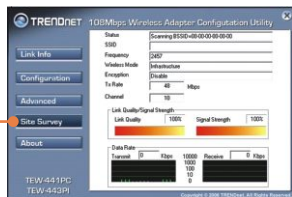
2. Click the **Wireless Networks** tab, uncheck **Use Windows to configure my wireless network settings**, and then click **OK**.



3. Double-click the **Wireless** icon in your system tray.



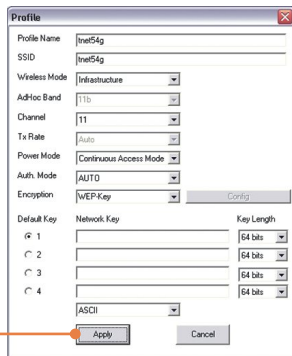
4. Click **Site Survey**.



5. Click the **SSID** that matches your wireless access point and then click **Connect**.



6. Set Profile settings of the wireless network and then click **Apply**.



Wireless configuration is now complete.

Q1: I inserted the TEW-441PC/443PI CD-ROM into my computer's CD-ROM Drive and the installation menu does not appear automatically. What should I do

A1: If the installation menu does not appear automatically, click Start, click Run, and type D:\Autorun.exe where "D" in "D:\Autorun.exe" is the letter assigned to your computer's CD-ROM Drive. And then click OK to start the installation.

Q2: I completed all the steps in the quick installation guide, but my card is not connecting to my access point. What should I do?

A2: You should first verify that the Network Name (SSID) matches your wireless router or access point's SSID. If they already match, you should check your TCP/IP properties to ensure that Obtain an IP Address Automatically is selected. Refer to your Windows User's Manual if you are unable to locate your TCP/IP properties.

Q3: Windows is unable to recognize my hardware. What should I do?

A3: Make sure your computer meets the minimum requirements as specified in Section 1 of this quick installation guide. Also, you must install the wireless configuration utility BEFORE you physically install your network card. Lastly, you may consider moving the card to a different PCI/PC Card Slot.

Q4: I cannot open the wireless configuration utility. What should I do?

A4: Access your device manager to make sure the adapter is installed properly. If you see a networking device with a yellow question mark or exclamation point, you will need to reinstall the device and/or the drivers. To access your device manager, right-click My Computer, click Properties, click the Hardware tab, and then click Device Manager.
