## WIN\_XP.TXT

- 1. In XP, enable TCP/IP protocol and make sure the workstation is receiving an IP address.
- 2. In Network Properties, add IPX/SPX protocol and Client for Netware Network.
- 3. From the Win95/WINNT Support diskette, run setup.exe. Follow the wizard and install both the "driver" and "setbox". It is possible that the installation will stop at 95%, wait for a couple of minutes, if there is no progress, click "Cancel". If a Window pops up and ask you to enter device name, click "Cancel".
- Go to "Start", "Program", "Print Server", and open "Setbox".
   Enter "Device name" (SC#######, you can find this number on the serial number label), IP address, subnet mask, and then click "Save".
   Go to "Start", select "Settings", and select "Printer and Fax".
- 7. Click on "Add printer". Select to add "local printer".
  8. XP will search for PNP printers and it finds none, click
  "Next".
  9. Click on "Create a new port".
  10. At "Port" click on "Browse", XP will find the print server
- 10. At "Port" click on "Browse", XP will find the print server name with assigned IP address; select the print server and then follow the instructions on the screen to finish adding the printer.
