## 2. Procéder à l'installation

1. Eteignez votre ordinateur et ouvrez le boîtier de votre ordinateur.



2. Insérez fermement la carte PCI dans un logement PCI libre, allumez ensuite l'ordinateur et attendez que le bureau Windows apparaisse.



Remarque : Windows 2003 Server/XP/2000/ME détecteront et installeront automatiquement les pilotes appropriés. Pour Windows ME, veuillez redémarrer le PC après avoir terminé l'installation du pilote. Pour Windows 98/98SE, veuillez consulter la partie Dépannage et les instructions concernant l'installation de pilotes.

3. Branchez un câble réseau RJ-45 de l'ordinateur à un port Ethernet libre de votre routeur ou de votre switch.

## **Q1: Windows is unable to recognize my hardware. What should I do?**

**A1:** First, verify that your computer meets the system requirements as specified in **Section 1**. Second, go to **Start -> Control Panel -> System > Hardware > Device Manager**. In the list of device types, double-click on **Network Adapters**. If you see the device with a yellow question mark or exclamation point next to it, double-click on it, click on **Drivers** and click **Update Drivers**. Follow the Hardware Update Wizard instructions as illustrated in **Section 2**. Third, if the device manager fails to recognize the presence of a new network adapter, verify that the network adapter is firmly seated in the PCI Slot. Fourth, insert the adapter into a different PCI slot on the computer.

## **Q2: Windows recognizes my new hardware, but I'm unable to connect to my network. What should I do?**

**A2:** First, verify that the RJ-45 Ethernet Cable is securely connected from your switch or router to your network adapter. Second, verify that the LEDs on your network card are lit. Third, verify that the TCP/IP settings are set to **Obtain an IP address automatically**.

## **Q3: How do I install the drivers on Windows 98?**

**A3:** Follow the steps below:

1. When the **Add New Hardware Wizard** appears, click **Next**.
2. Click **Search for the best driver for your device (Recommended)** and then click **Next**.
3. Click **Specify a location** and then click **Next**.
4. Insert the **Driver Floppy Disk** into your computer's **Floppy disk drive**. Double-click the **Floppy disk drive**, click on **Win98**, click **OK** and then click **Next**.
5. If prompted to, insert your **Windows 98 CD-ROM**, and then click **OK**.
6. Click **Finish**.
7. Click **Yes** to restart your computer.

Warranty service may be obtained by contacting TRENDnet office within the applicable warranty period for a Return Material Authorization (RMA) number, accompanied by a copy of the dated proof of the purchase. Products returned to TRENDnet must be pre-authorized by TRENDnet with RMA number marked on the outside of the package, and sent prepaid, insured and packaged appropriately for safe shipment.
