

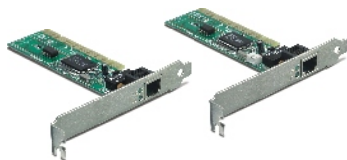

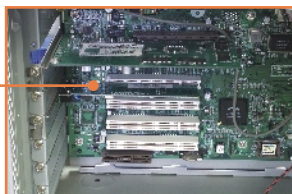

2. Como Instalar

1. **Desligue** seu computador e então abra seu gabinete.



2. Insira a placa PCI firmemente em um slot PCI disponível, e então **Ligue** o computador e aguarde até o desktop do Windows aparecer.



Nota: Windows 2003 Server/XP/2000/ME irá automaticamente detectar e instalar os drivers apropriados.

Para Windows ME, favor reiniciar o PC após a instalação completa do driver.

Para Windows 98/98SE, favor usar como referência a seção **Troubleshooting** para instruções de instalação do driver.

3. Conecte um cabo de rede RJ-45 do computador a uma porta Ethernet disponível em seu roteador ou switch.



Sua instalação agora está completa.

P1: O Windows não reconhece meu novo hardware. O que devo fazer?

R1: Primeiro, verifique se seu computador atende aos requisitos de sistema como especificados na **Seção 1**. Segundo, vá em **Start > Control Panel > System > Hardware > Device Manager** (Iniciar > Painel de Controle > Sistema > Hardware > Gerenciador de Dispositivos). Na lista de dispositivos, faça um duplo clique em **Network Adapters** (Adaptadores de Rede). Se você vir o dispositivo com uma interrogação amarela ou ponto de exclamação ao lado, faça um duplo clique, clique em **Drivers** e depois em **Update Drivers** (Atualizar Drivers). Siga as instruções de atualização de Hardware como ilustrado na **Seção 2**. Terceiro, se o gerenciador de dispositivos não reconhecer a presença do novo adaptador de rede, verifique se o adaptador de rede está firmemente encaixado no Slot PCI. Quarto, insira o adaptador em um Slot PCI diferente em seu computador.

P2: O Windows reconhece meu novo hardware, mas não consigo conectar minha rede. O que devo fazer?

R2: Primeiro, verifique se o cabo de rede RJ-45 está seguramente conectado do seu roteador ou switch até seu adaptador de rede. Segundo, verifique se os LEDs de sua placa de rede estão acesos. Terceiro, verifique se a configuração TCP/IP está configurada para **Obtain an IP address automatically** (Obtenha um Endereço IP Automaticamente).

P3: Como instalar o driver no Windows 98?

R3: Siga os passos abaixo:

1. Quando o **Add New Hardware Wizard** (Adicionar Novo Hardware) aparecer, clique **Next** (Próximo).
2. Clique **Search for the best driver for your device (Recommended)** (Procure por um melhor driver para seu Dispositivo (Recomendado)) e depois clique **Next** (Próximo).
3. Clique **Specify a location** (Especifique um local) e então clique **Next** (Próximo).
4. Insira o Disquete no Drive de Disquete do seu computador. Faça um duplo clique no **Drive de Disquete**, clique em **Win98**, clique **OK** e então clique **Next** (Próximo).
5. Quando estiver pronto, insira seu **CD-ROM do Windows 98** e então clique **OK**.
6. Clique **Finish** (Finalizar).
7. Clique **Yes** (Sim) para reiniciar o computador.

Products returned to TRENDnet must be pre-authorized by TRENDnet with RMA number marked on the outside of the package, and sent prepaid, insured and packaged appropriately for safe shipment.
