


2. Installation du matériel

Note: Remarque: Les ports d'insertion de Mini-GBIC sont partagés avec les port Gigabit Ethernet No. 25 et No. 26. Lorsque les ports d'insertion de Mini-GBIC sont utilisés, les ports Gigabit Ethernet No.25 et No.26 sont désactivés.

1. Branchez le **Cordon d'alimentation** à l'arrière du TEG-S2620is et à une prise de courant.



2. Branchez un câble réseau RJ-45 entre l'ordinateur et un port Ethernet disponible du TEG-S2620is.



3. Vérifiez que les voyants des panneaux suivants sont allumés : **POWER** et **LINK/ACT**.



3. Configuration du Switch

Remarque: Il est recommandé de configurer le switch depuis un ordinateur câblé. Avant de pouvoir configurer le Switch, une adresse IP statique doit être assignée à l'adaptateur réseau de votre ordinateur dans le sous-réseau de 192.168.0.x. L'adresse IP par défaut du Switch étant 192.168.0.1, assurez qu'aucun autre périphérique réseau n'a reçu la même adresse IP. (Consultez la rubrique « Dépannage » pour configurer les paramètres TCP/IP de votre PC.)

Navigateur Internet

1. Ouvrez votre navigateur Internet, tapez-y l'adresse **http://192.168.0.1** et appuyez sur la touche **Enter** (Entrez).



2. Saisissez le nom d'utilisateur et le mot de passe et cliquez sur **OK**.
Par défaut:
Nom d'utilisateur: **admin**
Mot de passe: **admin**



3. Choisissez les options de votre choix pour configurer les protocoles SNMP sur votre Switch.



HyperTerminal


1. Branchez le câble RS-232 d'un port série de votre PC Windows vers le port console de votre switch.



2. Allez sur Démarrer > Programmes > Accessoires > Communications > HyperTerminal



3. Saisissez un nom, choisissez une icône et cliquez sur OK.




4. Sélectionnez le bon port COM (p. ex. COM1, COM2) et cliquez sur OK.



5. Configurez les mises en place suivantes, cliquez sur **Appliquer** et sur **OK** :

Bits par seconde: 9600
Bits données: 8
Parité: Aucune
Bits d'arrêt: 1
Contrôle du flux: Aucun





6. Enfoncez la touche **Enter**.

7. Saisissez le nom d'utilisateur. Par défaut, Nom d'utilisateur: **admin**

8. Enfoncez la touche **Enter**.

9. Saisissez le mot de passe et cliquez sur **Enter**. Par défaut: Mot de passe: **admin**

Q1: How do I configure TCP/IP settings on my computer?

Windows Vista

1. Go into the **Control Panel**, click **Network and Internet**, click **Network and Sharing Center**, click **Manage Network Connections** and then right-click the **Local Area Connection** icon and then click **Properties**.



2. Click **Internet Protocol Version 4(TCP/IPv4)** and then click **Properties**. Then click on **Use the following IP address**, and make sure you assign your network adapter an IP address in the subnet of 192.168.0.x.

Windows XP/2000

1. Go into the **Control Panel**, double-click the **Network Connections** icon, and then right-click the **Local Area Connection** icon and then click **Properties**.



1. Click **Internet Protocol (TCP/IP)** and then click **Properties**. Then click on **Use the following IP address**, and make sure you assign your network adapter an IP address in the subnet of 192.168.0.x.

Q2: I typed `http://192.168.0.1` in my Internet Browser's Address Bar, but an error message says "The page cannot be displayed." How can I get into the TEG-S2620i's web configuration page?

A2: First, check your hardware settings again by following the instructions in section 2. Second, make sure the Power and LNK/ACT lights are lit. Third, make sure the TCP/IP settings are configured properly (see Q1). Fourth, since the Switch's default IP address is 192.168.0.1, make sure that no other network devices are assigned an IP address of 192.168.0.1.

Q3: If my network's IP is different than the Switch's range, what should I do?

A3: You should still configure the Switch first. After all the settings are applied, go to the Switch's configuration page, click on Administrator, click IP Configuration, change the IP address of the Switch to match your network's IP and then click **Apply**.

Q4: What are the default port settings for configuring the Switch through the console port using HyperTerminal?

A3: Bits per Second: 9600; Data bits: 8; Parity: None; Stop bits: 1; Flow control: None.

Q5: I changed the IP address of the switch, but I forgot it. How do I reset my TEG-S2620is?

A5: Follow the instructions below:

- 1) Connect the RS-232 cable from a serial port on your Windows PC to the console port on your computer.
- 2) Go to Start -> Programs -> Accessories -> Communications -> HyperTerminal.
- 3) Enter a name, select an icon and then click **OK**.
- 4) Select the correct COM port (e.g. COM1, COM2) and then click **OK**.
- 5) Configure the following settings, click **Apply** and then click **OK**:
Bits per second: 9600
Data bits: 8
Parity: None
Stop bits: 1
Flow control: None
- 6) Press **Enter**.
- 7) Enter the user name. By default, the user name is **admin**.
- 8) Press **Enter**.
- 9) Enter the password. By default, password is **admin**.
- 10) Press **Enter**.
- 11) Press Tab to navigate to **System Reset Configuration** and then press Enter.
- 12) Press Tab to navigate to **Factory Default** and then press Enter.
- 13) Press **Y** to continue.

The default IP address of the switch is 192.168.0.1.
