1. Antes de iniciar

Contenidos del paquete

Requisitos mínimos

- · Un PC con adaptador de red instalado correctamente
- Cable de Red CAT 5e o CAT 6
- · La superficie debe soportar al menos 450g para el conmutador
- La toma de corriente debe estar a 1,82 metros (6 pies) del conmutador
- Inspeccione visualmente el jack de corriente DC para comprobar que está conectado al adaptador de corriente
- Compruebe que existe una correcta regulación de la temperatura y una ventilación adecuada alrededor del conmutador
- · No coloque objetos pesados encima del conmutador

2. Cómo se instala

1. Conecte el **Power Cord** (Cable de alimentación) en la parte trasera del TEG-S80Dg y después a la toma corriente.



2. Mueva el switch de poder a la posición de encendido.



3. Conecte un cable de red RJ-45 CAT 5e o CAT 6 del PC a un puerto Ethernet disponible en el TEG-S80Dg.

- · Verde: Está encendido
- · Si no está iluminado: No está encendido

Enlace/ACT

- · Verde (Sólido): Enlace a otro dispositivo
- Verde (parpadeo): La actividad ocurre desde el enlace
- · Si no está iluminado: No se detecta nada en el puerto

100/1000Mbps

- Verde: Conexión para los puertos 2000Mbps (Full)
- Ámbar: Conexión para los puertos 100/200Mbps (Half/Full)
- Si no está iluminado: La conexión para el puerto es de 10/20Mbps (Half/Full) o no se detecta nada en el puerto

Troubleshooting

- 1. After connecting the Switch to a power outlet, the LEDs do not turn on.
 - 1. Check the connection of the power adapter to the TEG-S80Dg and the power outlet.
 - 2. Verify that the power switch is set to the On position.
 - 3. Check that the power outlet is receiving power.

2. When I connect a computer to one of the ports on the Switch, the Link/ACT LED turns on, but I am not getting Gigabit speeds.

- Check the LEDs. If the 100/1000Mbps LED is green, the computer's connection speed is 1000Mbps. If the 100/1000Mbps LED is amber, the computer's connection speed is 100Mbps. If the 100/1000Mbps LED is off, the computer's connection speed is 10Mbps.
- Check the Ethernet Cable. Make sure you are using CAT-5e or CAT-6 Ethernet Cables. Some CAT-5 cables are not rated to run in Gigabit.
- Make sure that you have a Gigabit Ethernet Adapter installed on your computer.

3. After I connect my PCs to the Switch, I am unable to share files.

- 1. Check the LEDs on the Switch. Make sure the Link/ACT LED is on.
- Check the network cable. The minimum length of the cable is 1.5 meters and the maximum length of the cable is 100 meters.
- 3. Disable any software firewall program.
- Verify that you have file sharing enabled. Please contact your Operating System support for more information.

4. After I connect my PCs to the Switch, I can only get onto the Internet from one computer.

The Switch was not designed to share Internet between multiple computers. You need to get an Internet router such as the TW100-S4W1CA.

5. Where is the uplink port located on the Switch?

Since all the ports on the Switch are Auto-MDIX, any of the ports can be used as an uplink port.
