1. Что нужно сделать в самом начале



2. Порядок установки

<u>Примечание:</u> Переключатель клавиатура/видео/мышь TK-200/TK-400 не требует установки драйверов или программ.



3. Присоедините к консольному порту переключателя совместно используемую клавиатуру, монитор и мышь.





4. Включите присоединенные компьютеры один за одним и дождитесь загрузки рабочего стола на каждом из них.



Установка завершена.

<u>Примечание:</u> Не нажимайте кнопки на переключателе клавиатура/видео/мышь для выполнения системной команды во время загрузки на компьютерах. Перейдите к разделу 3 Управление.

<u>Примечание:</u> Для переключения от компьютера к компьютеру используйте кнопка на передней панели.

3.1 кнопка

Переключение от компьютера к компьютеру – использовать кнопка.




3.2 Назначенные клавиши

Команды с клавиатуры подаются с помощью комбинации трех клавиш:

Команда = ScrLk + ScrLk + управляющая клавиша

После нажатия на клавишу ScrLk успейте нажать на ScrLk опять в течение 2-х секунд. Опять в течение 2-х секунд успейте нажать на управляющую клавишу. Если не нажать на клавишу в течение 2-х секунд, режим использования назначенных клавиш в коммутаторе отключится.

Приводим ниже необходимые команды для назначенных клавиш:



В " Hot Key" режиме, нажмите кнопку "Стрелка Вверх", для того чтобы выбрать следующий порт, нажмите кнопку "Стрелка Вниз", для того чтобы выбрать предыдущий порт, и нажмите кнопку "S", для того чтобы установить KVM в Auto-Scan режим.

Q1: Where is the AC adapter? I did not find one in the box.

A1: The TK-200/TK-400 do not require an AC adapter. It draws power from the PS/2 connection of your computers. As long as you are connected to the PS/2 port, your KVM switch will function.

Q2: I have the KVM switch connected properly, but my keyboard and mouse don't work.

A2: Please make sure your PS/2 ports are working properly by testing it with another mouse or keyboard. Once you confirm that the PS/2 ports are functional, please reboot your computers, and try to use the KVM switch again.

Q3: Can I connect or disconnect the KVM cables while the computers are turned on?

A3: Yes, you can connect or disconnect the KVM cables while the computers are turned on, because the interface is Hot-Pluggable.

Q4: Will the KVM switch restore the keyboard settings when switching between computers?

A4: Yes, the KVM switch will restore the keyboard settings when switching between computers. (i.e.: Cap lock, Num key, etc.)

Q5: How do I switch from one computer to another with the KVM switch?

A5: You can switch PCs by pressing the push button on the KVM switch or by using the Hot-Key commands. Go to Section 3 Operation for more information.
