1. Avant de commencer



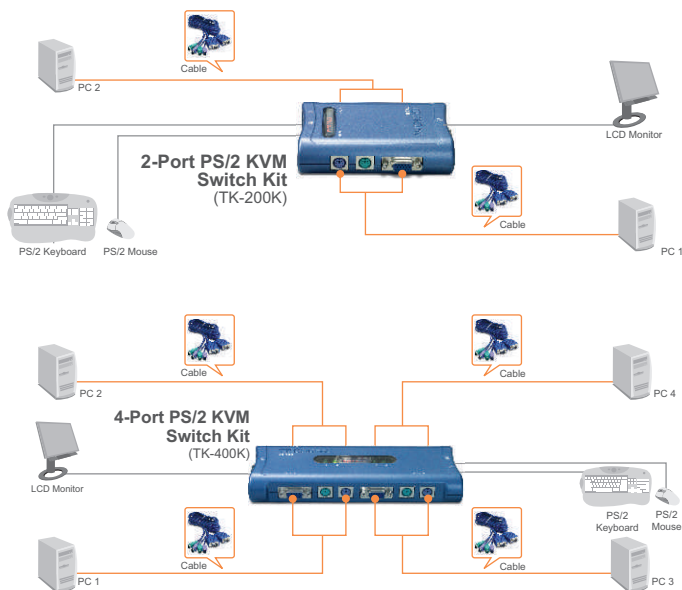

Application



2. Procéder à l'installation

Remarque : TK-200/TK-400 ne nécessite aucun pilote ni logiciel.

1. Eteignez tous les ordinateurs et leurs périphériques et débranchez tous les cordons d'alimentation.

2. Utilisez les câbles KVM pour brancher chaque PC au switch KVM.

3. Branchez le clavier, le moniteur et la souris partagées au Port console du switch KVM.



4. Allumez un par un les ordinateurs connectés et attendez que le bureau de chaque PC apparaisse à l'écran.



L'installation est maintenant complète.

Remarque : N'enfoncez pas les bouton de commande du switch KVM et n'utilisez pas de commande de raccourci pendant que les ordinateurs démarrent. Rendez-vous à la partie 3 « Fonctionnement ».

3. Fonctionnement

Remarque : Pour passer d'un ordinateur à l'autre, utilisez les boutons de contrôle situés sur le dessus ou les touches de raccourcis.

3.1 Bouton de contrôle

Enfoncez le bouton de contrôle pour passer d'un ordinateur à l'autre.

3.2 Touches d'accès rapide

Un raccourci clavier consiste en une combinaison de trois touches :

Accès rapide = ScrLk + ScrLk + Touche(s)

Après avoir appuyé sur la touche ScrLk, vous disposez de 2 secondes pour appuyer à nouveau sur cette dernière. Vous disposez alors de 2 secondes supplémentaires pour appuyer sur une touche de commande. Si vous n'enfonchez aucune touche dans les deux secondes, le mode « accès rapide » est annulé.

Voici les touches de raccourci:

ScrLk + **ScrLk** + **↑** = Chaîne suivante

ScrLk + **ScrLk** + **↓** = Chaîne précédente

ScrLk + **ScrLk** + **S** = Scan Automatique

En mode Touches de raccourci, utilisez la touche « flèche haut » pour choisir le port suivant, la touche « flèche bas » pour choisir le port précédent et la touche « S » pour mettre le Switch KVM en mode de recherche automatique (Auto Scan).

Q1: Where is the AC adapter? I did not find one in the box.

A1: The TK-200/TK-400 do not require an AC adapter. It draws power from the PS/2 connection of your computers. As long as you are connected to the PS/2 port, your KVM switch will function.

Q2: I have the KVM switch connected properly, but my keyboard and mouse don't work.

A2: Please make sure your PS/2 ports are working properly by testing it with another mouse or keyboard. Once you confirm that the PS/2 ports are functional, please reboot your computers, and try to use the KVM switch again.

Q3: Can I connect or disconnect the KVM cables while the computers are turned on?

A3: Yes, you can connect or disconnect the KVM cables while the computers are turned on, because the interface is Hot-Pluggable.

Q4: Will the KVM switch restore the keyboard settings when switching between computers?

A4: Yes, the KVM switch will restore the keyboard settings when switching between computers. (i.e.: Cap lock, Num key, etc.)

Q5: How do I switch from one computer to another with the KVM switch?

A5: You can switch PCs by pressing the push button on the KVM switch or by using the Hot-Key commands. Go to Section 3 Operation for more information.
