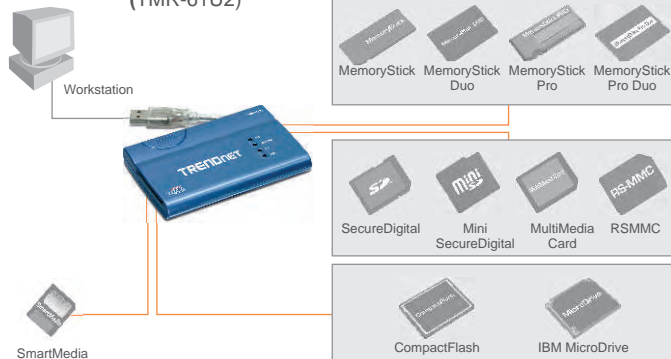

2. Instalación del Hardware

1. Encienda su PC y espere hasta que le aparezca el escritorio de Windows.



2. Conecte el Lector de tarjeta a un puerto USB disponible en su PC.



3. Instalación del controlador

Nota: Después de introducir el TMR-61U2 en una de sus ranuras USB, Windows (XP/2000) detectará el dispositivo de forma automática. Pase a la sección apropiada detallada a continuación antes de instalar el controlador.

Windows 2000/XP

1. Tras reiniciar su PC, Windows completará automáticamente la instalación de su nuevo hardware.

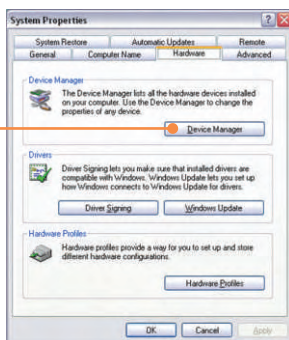

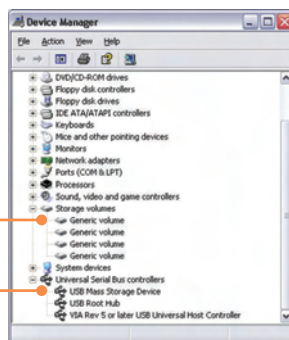
4. Verificar la instalación

Windows 2000/XP

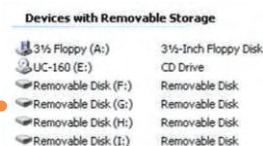
1. Haga clic derecho en **My Computer** (Mi PC) y luego haga clic en **Properties** (Propiedades). En de la pestaña **Hardware**, haga clic en el **Device Manager** (Gestor de dispositivo).



2. Compruebe que el **Generic volume** (Volumen Genérico) y el **USB Mass Storage Device** (Dispositivo de almacenamiento masivo USB) estén instalados y que no aparecen signos de exclamación visibles.



3. Vaya a **My Computer** (Mi PC) y compruebe que aparecen cuatros discos portátiles.

Q1: Can I connect or disconnect the USB cables while the computer is on?

A1: Yes, you can connect or disconnect the USB cable, or any external USB device while the computer is on, because the USB interfaces are Plug-and-Play and hot-pluggable.

Q2: I have a USB 1.1 cable. Can it work with USB 2.0 devices?

A2: Yes, it works but it may cause problems for connecting high-speed USB 2.0 external peripherals. Therefore it is recommended that you use a certified USB 2.0 cable.

Q3: After successful installation of the TMR-61U2 USB 2.0 6-in-1 Memory Card Reader/Writer, I inserted my memory card into the slot and it is not working? What should I do?

A3: Make sure the memory card is properly inserted in the right slot and make sure the light comes on.
