

- CD-ROM Drive
- USB Port: 2.0 or 1.1
- CPU: 300MHz or above / 800MHz or above (Windows Vista)
- Memory: 256 MB RAM or above / 512 MB RAM or above (Windows Vista)
- Windows 2000/XP/Vista

2. How to Install

Note: Do not connect the TU2-ETG into your computer until instructed to do so.

1. Insert the **Driver CD-ROM** into your computer's CD-ROM Drive.


2. Click **Run Autorun.exe** (Windows Vista only).




3. Click **Install Driver**, and then click your operating system.



4. Click **Next**. Then follow the **InstallShield Wizard** instructions.



5. Click **Finish**.



6. Connect the Adapter to an available USB port on your computer.



7. Drivers will install automatically.

8. Connect a Cat-5e or Cat-6 RJ-45 cable from the Adapter to a Switch, Router or Cable/DSL Modem.



Your installation is now complete.

Q1: Can I connect or disconnect the TU2-ETG while the computer is on?

A1: Yes, you can connect or disconnect the TU2-ETG while the computer is on because the USB interface is Plug-and-Play compliant and hot-pluggable.

Q2: Windows is unable to recognize my hardware. What should I do?

A2: First, make sure your computer meets the minimum requirements as specified in Section 1 of this Quick Installation Guide. Second, try plugging the adapter into a different USB port.

Q3: Windows recognizes my new hardware, but I'm unable to connect to my network. What should I do?

A3: First, verify that the network cable is securely connected from your switch or router to your adapter. Second, verify that the LEDs on your adapter are lit. Third, verify that the TCP/IP settings are set to **Obtain an IP address automatically**.

Q4: When I connect the adapter to a gigabit switch, I am not getting gigabit speeds. What should I do?

A4: Make sure you are using CAT-5e or CAT-6 Ethernet Cables. Some CAT-5 cables are not rated to run in Gigabit.
