System Requirements


The following items below are not included. Users must provide the items themselves. Make sure to have each item on hand before installation.

- Pan and tilt Internet camera (e.g. TV-IP410, TV-IP600, TV-IP612)
- Mounting screws and screw Anchors
- Dry Wall or Wood surface
- · Phillips screwdriver
- RJ-45 cable

2. Hardware Installation

<u>Note</u>: Configure your Internet Camera Server to match your network before installing the device.

TV-IP612P



TV-IP612P

1. Rotate the TV-H400's cover counter clockwise and remove the cover.



 Remove three screws and remove the protective plating from the TV-H400. Save these screws. You will need to use these screws later.



3. Run all necessary cables (network cable, Power Adapter cable, and the power terminals) through the wall mount.



4. Connect the power terminal to the provided 12V DC, 0.6A power adapter. Adjust the cable so that this connection is enclosed in the bracket. 5. Run the Ethernet cable and the IP Camera's power adapter cable through the opening located at the top of the TV-H400. 6. After inserting the appropriate cables, extend each cable to 6 inches for camera installation. 7. Use the provided rubber seal to seal the housing.


8. Secure the protective plating into the wall mount bracket using the thumb screw.



 Screw the wall mount bracket on top of the TV-H400 with the provided Allen wrench and three hexagon socket screws. The screws are in the plastic bag labeled Q2B.



10. Connect the three 5 cm Hex screws to the circular base bracket. Secure the Hex screws with the nuts and washers. The 5cm Hex screws are in the plastic bag labeled Q3. The nuts and washers are in the plastic bag labeled Q5.



11. Mount bracket BR003 to the camera enclosure using the three flat head screws. These screws are in the plastic bag labeled Q1.





12. Use three round head screws to mount the metal bracket BR004 on top of the 3 Hex screws. The three round head screws are in the plastic bag labeled Q6.





13. Align the holes on the bottom of the TV-IP612 with the locking posts on the metal bracket.

14. To secure the TV-IP612, push down and turn the IP Camera clockwise.




15. Connect the network cable and power adapter to the IP Camera.

16. Place the TV-H400's cover over the camera and rotate the cover clock-wise.



 Plug the power to the IP Camera and the camera enclosure into an available power outlet.

TV-IP410/TV-IP600



1. Rotate the TV-H400's cover counter clockwise and remove the cover.



Remove three screws and remove the protective plating from the TV-H400. Save these screws. You will need to use these screws later.






3. Run all necessary cables (network cable, Power Adapter cable, and the power terminals) through the wall mount.



4. Connect the TV-H400 power terminal to the provided 12V DC, 0.6A power adapter. 5. Run the Ethernet cable and the IP Camera's power adapter cable through the opening located at the top of the TV-H400. **6.** After inserting the appropriate cables, extend each cable to 6 inches for camera installation. 7. Use the provided rubber seal to seal the housing. 8. Secure the protective plating into the wall mount bracket using the thumb screw.

9. Screw the wall mount bracket on top of the TV-H400 with the provided Allen wrench and three hexagon socket screws. The screws are in the plastic bag labeled Q2B. 10. Connect the three 5 cm Hex screws to the circular base bracket. Secure the Hex screws with the nuts and washers. The Hex screws are in the plastic bag labeled Q3. The nuts and washers are in the plastic bag labeled Q5. 11. Mount bracket BR003 to the camera enclosure using the three flat head screws. These screws are in the plastic bag labeled Q1.



16. Connect the network cable and power adapter to the IP Camera.




17. Place the TV-H400's cover over the camera and rotate the cover clock-wise.



18. Plug the power to the Internet Camera Server and the camera enclosure into an available power outlet.

Troubleshooting

1. After I put my IP Camera in the enclosure, the image is distorted. What should I do?

- 1. Make sure that you have adjusted the focus on your camera.
- 2. Mount the TV-H400, so that it's not in direct view of the sun.

2. Does the TV-IP422 and TV-IP422W work with the TV-H400?

We do not recommend using the TV-IP422 and TV-IP422W with the TV-H400. The IR light will cause reflection.
